

# Country



A stuccoed floating hood with distressed Pine wood mantel sits above the range between two narrow windows. Tumble marbled tiles form a backsplash with central design consolidating the kitchen color scheme.

Cabinets on the cooking wall are lightly stained natural Pinewood. Grooved ends, decorative supporting corbel brackets and "Pea-pod" old brass pulls add country charm.

Framed with Pine wood turnings, this old fashioned cast iron Aga stove in cream sets the stage for this "unfitted" country kitchen. Directly opposite is the deep farmhouse style porcelain sink.

Contrasting the simple Pinewood cabinets on the outer wall, the island furniture features detailed moldings painted in two tones with accents in sage. Simply edged Kashmir granite provides the work surface.

The island sits on quarter sawn American Cherry wood floor planks. The lowered end provides a level for kneading dough as well as attractive wine and cookbook storage.
