Sandblasted glass-fronted doors on warm cherry wood cabinets contrast the bold hood while adding texture and depth without exposing the cabinet contents.

Made of faceted stainless steel, the imposing custom hood anchors the room at its focal point. The simply carved limestone mantel and corbels carry the bold statement of grandeur.

Beauharnais limestone tile is used on the diagonal as a backsplash. This promotes a lightness and continuity of surface to the elegant and open layout.

The English Brown granite on the island preparation surface contrasts the perimeter limestone counters. Adding color and interest, it's also used as pot rests flanking the range.

Wash-up sink is angled in the corner with stainless steel bowls under mounted in the Beauharnais limestone counter. The elevated ledge behind it provides a display surface while screening the sink from the dining area.
